10 Tips for Showing your Sheep:

- 1. Allow enough time to prepare your sheep before judging starts and be ready when your class is called.
- 2. Be smartly dressed.
- 3. Be polite to the Judge and other competitors.
- 4. If white coats are being worn keep them fastened.
- 5. Concentrate on showing your sheep. Don't worry about anyone else or talk to the person beside you. Be patient with your sheep especially if this is their first show.
- 6. Always keep an eye on the judge and don't relax after he/she has looked at your sheep. He/she may still be looking at your sheep when they are further down the line.
- 7. Be alert to what the judge or ring steward may want you to do, for example, turn your sheep around, let them go, etc.
- 8. Know the breeding and the age of your animals. Some people may be interested customers.
- 9. Wait until after judging before asking the judge questions they should be able to answer them!!
- 10. Don't worry if you don't win it's only one person's opinion and there's always another show.
